Mrs. Hatcher question if a letter was received regarding action item number one. Mayor Conard answered in the negative stating that he requested the motion be inserted on the agenda. Mrs. Hatcher stated that it was an excellent idea.

Mrs. Jack stated that the changes are minor and gave an explanation of the changes. Mayor Conard questioned if this will be expedited. Administrator Jack answered in the affirmative.
- 3) **Motion made by Mr. Carroll and Mr. Prisco** to adopt a Hazard Communications Program as required and outlined by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development **carried.**

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY:

Chief Tursi reported the Police Activity for November 2008: Investigations – 83, Adult Arrests Total – 72, Motor Vehicle Summons – 224, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 9, Parking Summons – 10 Juvenile Charges – 1, Protective Custody – 4, Juvenile Incidents at school - 2, Curfew Violations – 0, Stationhouse Adjustments – 0, False Alarm Calls – 25, False Alarm Warning Letters - 0, Domestic Violence Cases – 22, DWI Arrests – 8. Chief Tursi also reported the Detective services; various training that the Officers attended; meetings that were attended by the Officers, correspondence received, and grants that are currently being pursued as well as grant programs that have been received. A copy of the report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's office.

Mayor Conard questioned the Committee and the Public if there were any questions for the Chief of Police. No questions were presented.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS:

Mr. March reported that the Public Works Department is currently performing the fall leaf collection which is going well. Leaf Collection will continue until early January. Road maintenance was completed throughout the town. The Department also tended to down trees during a storm and prepared for Christmas in Riverside. Christmas Tree pickup will begin on January 12, 2009. Mr. March reported the activities for January 2009. Mrs. Hatcher thanked Mr. March and the Department for doing a great job. Mr. Carroll commended Mr. March and wished him much success in the future. A copy of the report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's office.

DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND FINANCE:

Mr. Prisco had nothing to report.

DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION:

Mr. Carroll stated that it has been a pleasure being on the Committee and it was an honor to serve the Community as a member of the Township Committee. Mr. Carroll thanked his supporters.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EVENTS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:

Mrs. Hatcher reported that Christmas in Riverside was a success. Mrs. Hatcher thanked the Public Works Department, the Fire Department and the Police Department for their support with Christmas in Riverside. Mrs. Hatcher thanked Mr.

Carroll for his dedicated service to the Town. Mayor Conard and Mr. Prisco also thanked Mr. Carroll for his service.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor Saponaro had nothing to report. Solicitor Saponaro stated that it has been a pleasure working with Mr. Carroll over the past two years.

CLERK – COLLECTOR'S REPORT:

Mrs. Dydek reported the Real Estate Collection Status for December 2008 as follows: current year – 96.30%, next year – 0.69% and the prior year - 99.96%.

Mrs. Dydek reported that there have been 705 dog licenses issued and 69 cat licenses. Mrs. Dydek also reported that she has received a person – person liquor license transfer for Jack's Liquors, and RFPs / RFQs are currently being reviewed for the 2009 professional appointments.

Mrs. Dydek stated that it has been an honor and privilege working with Mr. Carroll. Mr. Carroll thanked Mrs. Dydek and wished her much success in the future.

ENGINEER'S REPORT:

Mayor Conard questioned the Committee if there were any questions regarding the Engineer's Report that was submitted. No questions were presented. Mayor Conard stated that he believes that the reports given by the appointed professionals should be accepted by motion. **Motion made by Mr. Prisco and Mr. Carroll to accept the Engineer's Report as written carried.** The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

Mr. Prisco questioned Mr. Conard that only written reports will be approved by motion. Mayor Conard answered in the affirmative.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

Administrator Jack stated that her report has been submitted. Administrator Jack stated that \$180,000.00 was received by the New Jersey Department of Transportation for Phase III reconstruction of Filmore Taylor and Kossuth Streets. Funding was not received for Lee and Carroll Streets. Administrator Jack thanked the Township Committee, the Public Works Department and the Fire Department for their assistance with Christmas in Riverside. Mr. Prisco questioned if Saturday is a better day for the event than Friday. Mayor Conard and Administrator Jack answered in the affirmative. The events schedule is attached to the Administrator's Report for review. Mr. Prisco questioned the date for Memorial Day. Mr. Carroll stated that May 25, 2009 is Memorial Day. Administrator Jack stated that she would like to consolidate Community Day with Build Your Own Scarecrow Day in the future. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S REPORT:

Mayor Conard questioned the Committee if there were any questions regarding the Code Enforcement Officer's Report that was submitted. No questions were presented. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

PLANNER'S REPORT:

No report submitted.

Mayor Conard questioned if there was any documentation submitted from the Planners. Administrator Jack answered that nothing has been received in the last two months. Mayor Conard stated that this is unsatisfactory. Administrator Jack stated that the Planner's are aware that they need to send in reports monthly. Mayor Conard stated that every report that has been submitted by the current Planners have been a boiler plate. Mayor Conard stated his dissatisfaction with the performance of the Planners and asked the Committee to consider this when reviewing the RFPs / RFQs for the 2009 professional appointments. Mr. Carroll stated that he concurs with Mayor Conard's dissatisfaction.


