The regular meeting of the Riverside Township Committee was held on the above date at the Riverside Township Municipal Building with the following members present: Messrs. Prisco, Van Meter and Conard along with Township Administrator Meghan Jack, Deputy Municipal Clerk Nancy Elmeaze, Lieutenant William Eliason, and Solicitor Douglas Burry (representing Solicitor Saponaro). Mr. Polino and Mrs. Hatcher were absent.





**RESOLUTION 2012 - #86**  
**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE**  
**TAX COLLECTOR TO PLACE MUNICIPAL LIEN AGAINST**  
**CERTAIN BLOCKS AND LOTS.**

WHEREAS, the Township has identified certain blocks and lots, as a public nuisance due to failure to maintain the property; and

WHEREAS, the Codes of the Township of Riverside has made provisions in the event that the owner and/or tenant or person in possession shall refuse or neglect to abate or remedy the condition complained of after said notice, whereas the Township Committee may cause the condition complained of to be abated and remedied and shall thereafter certify the cost thereof to the Collector of Taxes of the Township of Riverside to be charged against said lands. The amount so charged shall forthwith become a lien upon such lands and shall be added to and become and form a part of the taxes next to be assessed and levied upon such lands, the same to bear interest at the same rate as taxes, and shall be collected and enforced by the same officers and in the same manner as taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Township notified the owners of said properties that maintenance was required and would be undertaken by the Township with the cost to be billed to said owners.

WHEREAS, the Township has abated the conditions and hereby places the cost of abatement as a lien against the attached blocks and lots in the amounts shown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Riverside approves such action.





Lieutenant Eliason reported the various trainings that the Officers attended, the various programs that the officers and the Chief participated in, and various awards and commendations that the police officers received. A copy of the report is on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

Mayor Conard reported the Delran Emergency Squad Activity for July 2012: Medical Emergencies – 68, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 1, Fire Stand Bys – 3, Non Emergency Transports – 3, Patients transported to the hospital – 51 and Patients refused treatment and transportation – 18.

**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS:**

Mr. March reported that the Public Works Department performed road maintenance throughout the Township, chipped branches every Monday and Friday, cut the grass at all parks and Township owned lots and ball fields and swept the residential roadways, completed preparations for the Riverside Car Show, collected bags of grass and picked up recycling buckets from the County. The activities for September 2012 were reported. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

**DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND FINANCE:**

Mr. Van Meter had no report.

**DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION:**

Mr. Prisco had no report.

**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EVENTS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:**

Mrs. Hatcher was absent. Mayor Conard reported on the Riverside Business Association Car Show.

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT:**

Solicitor Burry reported that Solicitor Saponaro previously sent in a written report.

**MUNICIPAL CLERK'S REPORT:**

Municipal Clerk Dydek was excused.

**ENGINEER'S REPORT:**

Mayor Conard asked the Committee if there were any questions regarding the Engineer's Report that was submitted. No questions were presented. A copy of the report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's office.

**ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:**

Administrator Jack reported that the contract has been awarded for Phase VI Filmore, Taylor, Kossuth Streets Project which would include the 400-500 blocks of Filmore for a mill/overlay, the 500 block of Jefferson for a reconstruction, the 600 block of Jefferson for a mill/overlay, and the 200-300 blocks of Madison for reconstruction. The work for this project should commence within one – two months and the affected residents will be notified. Because this project had to go out for a second bid, it did not include New Jersey Avenue or other base repairs that are located throughout the Township. Willingboro Township has submitted a proposal to repair the storm drain on New Jersey Avenue which was reviewed by the Engineer and is deemed a reasonable proposal. Administrator Jack informed the residents that the Township is having problems with the storm drain inlets throughout the Township. If any residents see a problem with a storm drain, please immediately report that inlet to the Township. The Township is still waiting for the County to adopt their budget so that a tax rate may be struck and the Township may send out the reconciled tax bills. Hovnanian is expected to appear at the next Planning Board Meeting for final site plan and subdivision approval. Mayor Conard asked the Committee if there were any questions for the Administrator. Mr. Van Meter requested the Administrator to give a small synopsis of Monroe Street. Administrator Jack stated that the Township has received a contract with FEMA to complete the repairs. FEMA is funding the repair project. The Township Engineer has been authorized to bring the designs and the bidding of the project; however it has come to the Township's attention that DEP approval is needed before beginning the project. The anticipated window of approval from DEP is between 90 and 120 days. Therefore, the anticipated completion of the project is a ten month time period.

The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

**RENTAL INSPECTOR'S REPORT:**

The Rental Inspector's report has been distributed. Mayor Conard questioned if the Committee had any inquiries. No inquiries were presented. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

**Motion made by Mr. Van Meter, seconded by Mr. Prisco approving all the reports that were submitted carried.**

Mayor Conard stated that he spoke with Gary Haman regarding the Business Development Committee. Mr. Haman would like Bruce Behmke appointed to the Business Development Committee. **The Township Committee unanimously approved Mr. Behmke's appointment to the Business Development Committee.**


**PUBLIC PORTION**
