STATEMENT:

3. Filed written notice with the Clerk of the Township of Riverside on January 3, 2012.

The regular meeting of the Riverside Township Committee was held on the above date at the Riverside Township Municipal Building with the following members present: Messrs. Prisco, Van Meter, Mrs. Hatcher and Mr. Conard along with Township Administrator Meghan Jack, Municipal Clerk Susan M. Dydek, and Solicitor Saponaro. Mr. Polino was absent.

Motion made by Mr. Prisco, seconded by Mrs. Hatcher to excuse Mr. Polino's absence. (Mr. Polino is currently serving in the Armed Forces) **carried.**

Motion made by Mr. Van Meter and Mrs. Hatcher that the following minutes be approved as written: the Work Session Meeting of January 18, 2012 and the Regular Meeting of January 18, 2012 be approved as written carried.

Mayor Conard opened the meeting to the public for agenda items only.

WHEREAS, the Township of Riverside publicly advertised in the Burlington County Times, the official newspaper, the Request for Proposals / Request for Qualifications for Professional Services with a submission deadline to submit such Request for Qualifications / Request for Proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Riverside has complied with the minimum requirements pursuant to N.J.S.A 19:44A-20.7 and this appointment and contract is being awarded through the fair and open process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Riverside, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached contract with Long, Marmelo + Associates for a one-year term commencing on January 1, 2012 and ending on December 31, 2012. The total hourly rate to be dispersed by the Township of Riverside shall not exceed \$150.⁰⁰. The resolution and contract are on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk; and

2. The firm will be required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975 C. 127.



WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to amend this provision to allow for an increase in certain annual fees;



COMMITTEE REPORTS:**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY:**

Chief Tursi reported the Police Activity for January 2012: Investigations – 127, Adult Arrests Total – 106, Motor Vehicle Summons – 182, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 11, Juvenile Charges – 8, Curfew Violations – 3, Protective Custody – 0, Domestic Violence Cases – 13, Summons for False Alarms – 0, False Alarm Calls - 24. Chief Tursi reported on a Nigerian Scam were people go onto Craig's list and take apartment rentals and use false names for potential renters to send them their personal information. This scam has wiped out people's bank accounts. Chief Tursi also reported the various training that the Officers attended, the

various programs that the officers and the Chief participated in, and various awards and commendations that the police officers received. A copy of the report is on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

Mayor Conard reported the Delran Emergency Squad Activity for January 2012: Medical Emergencies – 71, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 1, Fire Stand Bys – 6, Non Emergency Transports – 0, Patients transported to the hospital – 52 and Patients refused treatment and transportation – 20.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS:

Mrs. Hatcher stated that Mr. March will give the report. Mr. March reported that the Public Works Department has completed the annual Christmas tree pick – up and canvassed the Township twice for branches. The Department cleaned leaves and brush from all Township fields and lots. There was one snow storm that required salting. Road maintenance was performed. The activities for February 2012 were reported. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

Mrs. Hatcher questioned the cleaning of the inlets on Scott Street. Administrator Jack stated that the County machine is broken so Riverside will be cleaning all of the inlets. Administrator Jack also stated that she will be in contact with the business owners to ask them if they would inform their tenants not to dispose of trash in the inlets. Mrs. Hatcher requested if the Riverside Business Association representative Mr. Costello would also inform the members of the Riverside Business Association.

DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND FINANCE:

Mr. Van Meter reported that the tax sale notices have been mailed and the tax sale will be held on April 5, 2012. The second quarter property tax payments will be due on May 1, 2012 and there is a ten day grace period through May 10, 2012.

DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION:

Mr. Prisco reported that on Sunday January 22, 2012 the Riverside Youth Athletic League (RYAA) had their fundraiser and it was well attended. Also, opening day is scheduled for April 14, 2012 and field clean – up will be held on March 24th and the 31st. Mr. Prisco questioned Administrator Jack if she notified the RYAA of the Easter egg hunt and Administrator Jack answered in the affirmative. Administrator Jack informed Ms. Drakeley to contact Mr. March regarding the infield mix.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EVENTS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:

Mrs. Hatcher reported that the Township will be having their first Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade on March 17, 2012 beginning at 12:00p.m. There will be bag pipes, dancers, and other organizations that will participate in the parade. The Easter Egg Hunt will be held on

March 31, 2012 at Whomsley Field. This will begin at 11:00am. The Riverside Youth Athletic League will have opening day on April 14, 2012 at 12:00pm. On April 21, 2012, the Riverside Business Association will hold the Pet Parade. Sign-ups for the Pet Parade will begin at 9:00am and the parade will begin at 10:00am.

Mrs. Hatcher also reported that for Economic Development, that redevelopment is moving forward and developers are anticipated to be at the next Planning Board Meeting.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor Saponaro had no report.

CLERK – COLLECTOR'S REPORT:

Municipal Clerk/Deputy Tax Collector Dydek reported that the Real Estate Tax Collection Status as follows: Prior Year – 97.72%, Current Year – 46.09% and Next Year – 0.00%.

Municipal Clerk Dydek reported that she submitted a written report to the Committee. Mrs. Dydek reported that 638 dog licenses have been issued and 40 cat licenses have been issued. Licenses should have been procured by January 31, 2012 to avoid the \$15.00 late fee. Rabies certificates must be good through November 1, 2012 to obtain a dog license. The Primary Election will be held on June 5, 2012 and the General and School Elections will be held on November 6, 2012.

Copies of the reports are on file on the Municipal Clerk's Office.

ENGINEER'S REPORT:

Mayor Conard asked the Committee if there were any questions regarding the Engineer's Report that was submitted. No questions were presented. A copy of the report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's office.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

Administrator Jack reported that the Emergency Management Director has recommended that the Township consider moving Emergency Management to the Municipal Building. Administrator Jack stated that she has applied for a grant to assist in the recommendation. Also a letter of intent has been received regarding residents that have sustained property damage from the last hurricane in the Swamp Poodle area. This would either be for an acquisition of properties or have them raised above the flood level.

The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

RENTAL INSPECTOR'S REPORT:

The Rental Inspector's report has been distributed. Mayor Conard questioned if the Committee had any inquiries. No inquiries were presented. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.


