



**COMMITTEE REPORTS:****DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY:**

Lieutenant Eliason reported the Police Activity for May 2011: Investigations – 151, Adult Arrests Total – 110, Motor Vehicle Summons – 216, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 17, Juvenile Charges – 6, Curfew Violations – 0, Protective Custody – 0, Domestic Violence Cases – 12, Summons for False Alarms – 0, False Alarm Calls - 14. A copy of the report is on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

Mayor Conard reported the Delran Emergency Squad Activity for May 2011: Medical Emergencies – 62, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 3, Fire Stand Bys – 4, Non

Emergency Transports – 3, Patients transported to the hospital – 44 and Patients refused treatment and transportation – 21.

**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS:**

Mr. Van Meter reported that the Public Works Department has been performing road maintenance throughout the Township, picked up branches throughout the Township, and started picking up bags of grass on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month. Friday morning sweeps are continuing and the sweeper is currently in the Upper Avenues Section. The Department cut grass all at Township parks, lots and ball fields. Preparations were done for the Memorial Day Parade and all went well. The activities for July 2011 were reported. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

**DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND FINANCE:**

Mr. Prisco reported that the second quarter property tax payments were due May 1 with a ten day grace period. Delinquent notices were printed and mailed on May 17, 2011. Now that the budget has passed, the Tax Collector will print tax bills after receiving State and County approvals. Should the grace period for the third quarter need to be extended (25 days from the postmark date), a Resolution will be prepared and brought forward to the Committee for passage. Notification will be sent in the Tax Bills informing the extension if needed.

**DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION:**

Mrs. Hatcher reported that Township is moving forward with the Spring Garden Parks Project.

**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EVENTS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:**

Mrs. Hatcher reported that the Pet Parade was a success and thanked Mr. Paul Costello and the Riverside Business Association for their assistance. \$831.00 was collected and donated to the Red Cross. Local Businesses donated items and services to help with the collection efforts. The Basketball Free Throw Tournament will be held on July 12<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and the 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:00pm. The banquet will be held on July 27<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm.

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT:**

Solicitor Saponaro reported that all of the Tax Appeals have been settled and he is currently reviewing the Public Assembly request.

**CLERK – COLLECTOR’S REPORT:**

Municipal Clerk Dydek reported that she submitted a written report to the Committee. Mrs. Dydek reported that 625 dog licenses have been issued and 65 cat licenses have been issued. Adam Holgersen and Thomas Kirby have been hired as Temporary Animal Census Officers and will be canvassing the Township documenting unregistered animals.

**ENGINEER’S REPORT:**

Engineer Hugh Dougherty reported on the following projects: Kossuth, Filmore and Taylor Street Phase IV, Kossuth, Filmore and Taylor Streets Phase V, Kossuth, Filmore and Taylor Streets Phase VI, the miscellaneous inlet repairs, and Whomsley Field. Mayor Conard question Engineer Dougherty if Public Service Electric and Gas was notified that Kossuth Street was being resurfaced. Engineer Dougherty answered in the affirmative. Mayor Conard stated that Public Service Electric and gas has opened Kossuth Street and it was not an emergency. A brief discussion ensued concerning increasing the fees or adding an escrow account for Utilities with regard to Street Opening Permits. Mrs. Hatcher questioned the status of the Monroe Street Project. Administrator Jack stated that FEMA asked for more information and it was provided to them. The Township is waiting for a response. The inlets on N. Pavilion Avenue were briefly discussed. A copy of the report is on file in the Municipal Clerk’s office.

**ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT:**

Administrator Jack reported that the Township was audited by the Department of Environmental Protection and the Township is in compliance. The preconstruction meeting for the Phase V of Kossuth, Filmore and Taylor Streets is scheduled to be held on July 11, 2011 at 6:00pm in the Court room.

**RENTAL INSPECTOR’S REPORT:**

The Rental Inspector’s report has been distributed. Mayor Conard questioned if the Committee had any inquiries. No inquiries were presented. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk’s Office

PUBLIC PORTION

- 1) **Ms. Judy Kirshner 123 Kossuth Street**, questioned the status of Teicher Project. Administrator Jack stated that the Department of Environmental Protection has stated that they have met with Mr. Teicher and gave him a plan and that the site will be monitored. Mr. Teicher has hired a new contractor. Ms. Kirshner stated that the debris that is there is covered with white tarps that are blowing off the debris in the wind. Ms. Kirshner also stated her concerns about pooling water and mosquitoes and questioned the timeframe for the debris removal. Administrator Jack stated that the Department of Environmental Protection will contact the Township regarding the timeframe of the debris removal.
- 2) **Ms. Rose Thomas 8 Morton Street**, questioned if the basketball court in the Spring Garden Park will be made into a full court with a fence around it. Administrator Jack answered in the affirmative; there will be gates that lock at curfew. Ms. Thomas stated that previously, she was a member of the Riverside Beautification Committee. As a member of this committee, Ms. Thomas spoke with representatives from neighboring municipalities regarding their basketball courts. Most of the neighboring municipalities have removed their full courts and replaced them with half courts. This helped deter drugs, fights and other problems that were brought into the towns by non-residents who came to use the full basketball courts. Ms. Thomas expressed concern that by making the basketball courts into full courts, there will be an increase in crime and contribute to an already existing parking problem in that area. Ms. Thomas stated that she would like to see more trash cans placed in the park.
- 3) **Ms. Kathy Jacobs 127 Kossuth Street**, questioned if Ryan Homes was interested in the Teicher lots. Administrator Jack stated that there has been verbal interest but the Township has not received anything in writing as of yet. Administrator Jack stated that should Ryan Homes be interested, they have through 2012 to act with the Planning Board. Ms. Jacobs questioned if the Teicher Organization will still have to clean up the site? Administrator Jack answered in the affirmative.

**Hearing nothing further from the Public, motion made by Mr. Van Meter and Mrs. Hatcher carried: Public Portion be closed.**

**There being no further business to attend to, motion made by Mr. Van Meter and Mr. Prisco that the meeting be adjourned, and so declared by Mayor Conard.**
