Mrs. Hatcher made a motion to adopt Resolution 2011 - #45 seconded by Mr. Prisco carried.


ACTION:

RESOLUTION 2011 - #45

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2011 FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Chapter 150 currently provides for provisions allowing for the levying of annual fees; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to amend this provision to allow for an increase in certain annual fees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Riverside, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 150 is hereby amended as follow:

150-111. Animals.

A. The person applying for the license and registration tag shall pay a fee of \$15 for each dog to be licensed hereunder and the sum of \$1 for the registration tag of each dog. For each annual renewal, the fee for the license and the registration tag shall be the same as for the original license and tag. There shall be a \$4 discount given for all dogs that are spayed or neutered.

B. The person applying for the license and registration tag shall pay a fee of \$15 for each cat to be licensed hereunder and the sum of \$1 for the registration of each dog. For each annual renewal, the fee for the license and the registration tag shall be the same as for the original license and tag. There shall be a \$4 discount given for all cats that are fixed.

C. Any person applying for a dog or cat license, either for renewal of the previous license or for the first time, and failing to comply with the time requirements set forth herein will be charged an administration fee to compensate for the additional administrative procedures in the amount of \$15, which is in addition to all other fees set forth herein.

D. Any person applying for a dog or cat license, for renewal of a license that was not renewed the previous license, and failing to comply with the time requirements set forth herein will be charged an additional administration fee, in the amount of \$4.20 for a non- spayed or non – neutered dog or cat and \$1.20 for a spayed or neutered dog or cat to compensate for the additional administrative procedures which is in addition to all other fees set forth herein.

E. The annual license fee for a kennel providing accommodations for 10 or fewer dogs shall be \$100 and for more than 10 dogs, \$250. The annual license fee for an animal hospital providing accommodations for 10 or fewer dogs, cats or other animals shall be \$100 and for more than 10 dogs, cats or other animals, \$250. The annual license fee for a pet shop shall be \$100. No fee shall be charged for a shelter or pound.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that this resolution will be retroactive to January 1, 2011.
