- 2) Alice Smith – 413 Arch Street Delran, NJ – Ms. Smith stated that she is appreciative that the Township will be supporting them for Riverside Township's 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary next year. The Historical Book that they are writing should be ready by then. Ms. Smith stated that the Historical Society is interested in obtaining the Train Station and said that a deed search has to be done to locate the owner.


Hearing nothing further from the public, motion made by Mr. Kimble and Mr. Frey to close Public Portion carried.
